# -Adjustable angle installation procedure

1. Loosen the four retaining screws without removing them.



2. Connect the wires of the lamp and the lamp post to their corresponding terminals (L, N, GND), insert the lamp tube into the lamp post, and choose the appropriate angle.

3. Confirm the installation angle and tighten the retaining screws (torque 10-12  $N{\cdot}m).$ 



4. Installation complete.
